



Please be assured that the health and well-being of Torchlight Academy's community is important to us. We continue to adjust to meet the requirements of current health guidelines in an effort to safeguard our students and staff. There are some changes that will take place this school year such as, but not limited to:

- Increase the teaching of healthy hygiene behaviors.
- Breakfast and lunch will be brought to the classrooms.
- Limited visitation and access to the school building.
- Students and staff are required to wear a face covering in the buildings; however, they are optional when outdoors at recess.
- Continuous cleaning of high touch areas.
- No access to water fountains. We have however, installed a water system for students to use to refill their water bottles. Therefore, we are asking that students bring a refillable water bottle to school each day, that can be washed each night. The bottle must be labeled with the child's name and made of a substance that will not break easily.



#### Emphasis on proper nutrition - We have a restaurant grade kitchen!

Torchlight Academy participates in the National School breakfast and lunch program's Community Eligibility Provision (CEP). With this program each child receives breakfast and lunch <u>AT NO COST</u>. This saves each family as much as \$1,200.00 a year!! Also saves time, since no need to prepare daily lunches.

We do not allow fast food nor sugary treats to enter the building because research shows that those food items lead to poor health.



#### <u>Accommodating Children with Special Dietary Needs</u>

A child with a dietary disability who must be provided food substitutions or special diet, must have a written statement or diet order signed by a licensed physician (forms can be picked up in the office).

## Kindergarten Students

State law (G.S 130A-152(a)) requires that each student entering Kindergarten presents the following proof:

- Copy of his/her birth certificate
- Copy of immunization or certificate of religious exemption
- Completed Health Assessment Medical report from the child's doctor
- Must be <u>5 years</u> old by <u>August 31</u>, 2021

This information must be submitted by September 30, 2021, for ALL Kindergarteners.

#### **Immunization Requirements for Grade 7 Students**

In accordance with North Carolina Immunization Law, each child entering grade 7 or by 12 years of age, whichever comes first; must submit proof of receiving one dose of Tdap (tetanus, diphtheria, pertussis) and one dose of meningococcal conjugate vaccine; or certificate of religious exemption. This information must be submitted by September 30, 2021, for ALL 7<sup>th</sup> graders.
